FAQ

My pet is sick. Can I bring them to see you?

We do not see sick pets or those needing urgent care. The only conditions our veterinarians treat are pets with skin conditions, allergies and ear infections.

How should I bring my pet into the clinic?

- Cats need to be in carriers
- Dogs should be on a 4-6 foot leash (please do not allow retractable leashes to be fully extended!)
- Please be respectful of other pets and families by keeping your pet right beside you and under control.
- For aggressive dogs, as a courtesy to other pets and people, keep a safe distance apart. If weather permits, keep him/her in your car if possible.

Do you have a regular office we can visit during the week?

We do not have a full-service office, but we can refer you to a clinic in your area.

Do you take credit cards?

We accept, cash, credit, and debit. No checks and no CareCredit.
